DRIVER READINESS CHECKLIST

IN CAB



- Have printed or digital log books on board
- Ensure they are complete and accurate
 - Certify daily
 - Assign any unassigned driving time that belongs to you
 - Keep current and log in before your trip starts
- Know how to transfer digital logs to the inspector
- Know how to keep records if the ELD fails
- Keep 8 days of blank paper logs in case of failure (required)

PRE-TRIP INSPECTION



- Check cargo is secure
 - Inspect all straps and chains for frays, cuts or stretching
 - Inspect blocking and bracing to prevent shifting
 - Don't forget to secure dunnage, tarps, spare tires, etc.
- Walkaround basics
 - Check all headlights, marker, signal and brake lights
 - Verify tire tread depth and check for audible air leaks
 - Confirm the onboard fire extinguisher is charged
 - Have 3 reflective triangles or flares
